 - **Fall Planning Session**



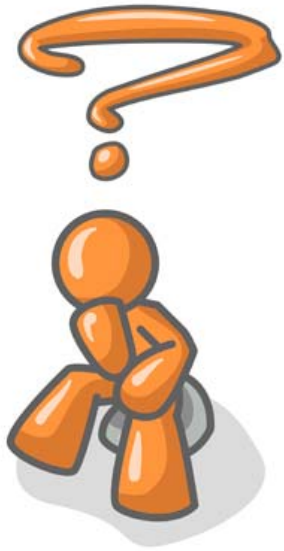
Teamwork...
