JotForm

- | Pros | Cons | How we use it |
|---|--|---|
| <ul style="list-style-type: none">- Free up to 100 responses/mo- Unlimited questions/fields- Stores unlimited number of previous forms- Both anonymous and trackable survey results- Mobile friendly- Easier to manipulate than MedHub | <ul style="list-style-type: none">- Many of the things we use it for could be done in MedHub- Exporting data is limited | <ul style="list-style-type: none">- Semiannual resident self evaluation |



Survey Monkey

- | Pros | Cons | How we use it |

| <ul style="list-style-type: none">- Free up to 10 ?s- Stores previous surveys- Easily export data- Both anonymous and trackable survey results | <ul style="list-style-type: none">- Subscription required for more than 10 ?s- Messages are sent from server- not your e-mail- Could go to recipients' SPAM folder | <ul style="list-style-type: none">- End of Year award nominations (survey)- ACGME annual update-Scholarly Activity info for Faculty (form) |



Testmoz

Pros

- Free up to 20 ?s Annual subscription only \$20
- Public tests- no username or access required
- Mobile friendly interface
- Short URL if manually entering

Cons

- Subscription required for more than 20 ?s
- Does not store your test links for you (unless you subscribe)
- Can only use if it is a "correct answer" scenario

How we use it

- MOC credit self-assessments (evaluation/test)
- Tracking resident engagement during weekly conferences (evaluation/test)



MedHub

Pros

- Centralized data storage
- Robust reporting- including Dashboards
- Multiple response formats (true/false, scale, comments)

Cons

- Users must be granted access to the program
- Steep learning curve for users and admin
- Cannot make changes to an evaluation once one has been completed
- Not mobile friendly

How we use it

- Monthly Evaluations
- Milestone Evaluations
- Public Link- anonymous nursing or patient evaluations



Google Drive

Pros

- Centralized data storage
- Stores previous documents
- Easily export data
- Both anonymous and trackable survey results

Cons

- Data is robust but requires a bit of time to reformat


How we use it

- Grant Applications (form)
- CME conference feedback (survey)
- Resident Operative Evaluations
- Intern Procedure Sign-off (evaluation)

Distribution: Hyperlinks

- Type of Hyperlink
 - User-defined text (short)
 - Pathway text (long)
- Places to utilize Hyperlinks
 - E-mails
 - Meeting planners
 - Office Documents (Word, Excel, PowerPoint, etc)
 - Text messages
- Bookmark Hyperlinks
 - Save shortcut to Desktop
 - Save to home screen on mobile device
 - Save to favorites in internet browser



Distribution: QR Codes

- QR Codes are Hyperlinks in Print
 - Links to websites
 - Send e-mails/text messages
 - Open Office documents/PDFs
- Places to utilize QR Codes
 - Printed attendance lists
 - Flyers
 - Stickers on badges
- Free QR Code Readers
 - i-nigma
 - QR reader
 - Shop Savvy (good for price matching too)



Best Practices

- Data Collection
 - Surgeon-proof your tools
 - Tracking responses vs anonymous responses vs completer field
 - Minimal revisions once published
- Data Storage
 - Snapshot vs Longitudinal data
 - Export/PDF data and upload to MedHub
 - Remove exported data from collected responses
