- Jaundice
- Cholecystitis
- Gallstone disease
 - Acute cholecystitis
 - Chronic cholecystitis
 - Cholelithiasis
 - Biliary pancreatitis
 - Gallstone ileus
- Anatomic cholecystic and biliary systems
- Gallbladder neoplasms
 - Polyps
 - Cancer (incidental)
- Iatrogenic bile duct injury

ROCKS

- Gallbladder cancer
- Closure of the bile duct
- Choledochal cyst
- Gallstone cholecystitis
- Ampullary mucosal prolapse of CBD dysfunction

ESSENTIAL – STANDARD

- Cholecystectomy with/without cholangiogram
 - open
- Cholecystectomy with/without cholangiogram
 - laparoscopic

ADVANCED – ESSENTIAL

- Cholecystectomy
- Common bile duct exploration – open
- Cholecystectomy
- Cholelithostomy/ostomy
- Operation for gallbladder cancer (when found incidentally)
- Repair acute common bile duct injury

COMPLEX

- Laparoscopic common bile duct exploration

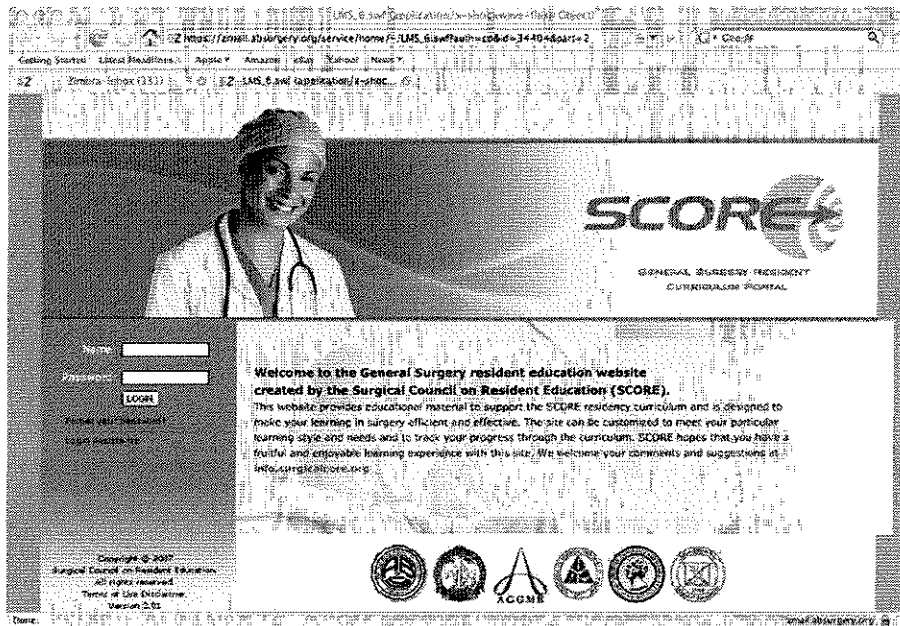

Update:

- **Testing** at 32 general surgery programs for phase 1 of the SCORE General Surgery Resident Curriculum Portal.
- **Evaluation** of the SCORE Portal and Curriculum by SCORE Curriculum Evaluation Committee, ABS and APDS.
- **Release** of the SCORE portal at ALL general surgery programs is scheduled for summer 2009.

Overview of SCORE Portal:

- **Curriculum Portal:** Access to disease/condition and operation/procedure modules with objectives, open-ended questions, textbook chapters, and videos.
- **My SCORE:** Edit personal information, bookmark website URLs, and save search results.
- **My Program Manager:** Publish news and announcement messages to your program, manage your resident and faculty users, and create assignments
